You can create color schemes based on 23 classic color-harmony rules, such as the Complementary, Analogous, Monochromatic, and Triad options, or you can create custom harmony rules.

Working with the Color Guide Panel in Adobe Illustrator

This is how we work with the color guide panel in Adobe Illustrator. When you're in Adobe Illustrator, a lot of the times you want to adjust your colors, and maybe you want to adjust them according to certain aspects or characteristics of a color. So let's say we pick out a color right now. Let's say we pick out something yellow, goldish.

How to Work with the Adobe Illustrator Color Guide Panel

The guides feature in Photoshop and Illustrator is helpful when users want to position the elements of a document precisely. However, because the default color of the guides is cyan, it is not suitable on a bright document. This color often makes spotting the thin lines difficult for users. Here is how to change it to your desired color.

Photoshop and Illustrator: Change the Guide Color and Style

Find the Illustrator "Color Guide" on the right side panel. Click on the icon and drag it onto your artboard. The Color Guide icon looks like a small triangle. When you hover over it goes from gray to rainbow colors. You can also make it appear by going to the "Window" menu and choosing "Color Guide."

Create or edit color groups, and assign colors using the Edit Colors/Recolor Artwork dialog box. A. Create and edit a color group in the Edit tab B. Assign colors in the Assign tab C. Select a color group from the Color Groups list.

Loading the Default Pantone Books / Libraries in Illustrator. Where Are the Pantone Colors in Adobe Illustrator

The Color Guide panel generates a set of color swatches that go well with a base color that you define. That set of colors adjusts, chameleon-like, as you add (or delete) colors from your illustration. As you assign new colors, the Color Guide panel changes. To view the Color Guide panel, choose Window>Color Guide.

Illustrator CC Color Guides and Color Themes — dummies

This color chart represents a set of common colors ordered by name as an one-page overview. Each line consists of RGB values, HEX value, the color's name, luminance value, HSL values and a color rectangle. You can click on a color rectangle to import the color into the HSL Color Picker. RGB, HEX or HSL values can be used as HTML color code or CSS color code.
