Already known as the Hospital Center of the South, Temple, Texas, became a city of unprecedented activity when it was awarded a general hospital. The Veterans Administration Hospital in Temple as we know it now began its existence as U. S. Army McCloskey General Hospital in 1942. The opening of McCloskey General Hospital and nearby Camp Hood (later Fort Hood) in 1942 marked a new era in the growth of Temple and Bell County, both economically and culturally.
