When a patent is granted, the invention becomes the property of the inventor. Like other forms of property, a patent can be licensed or assigned. Patents grant territorial rights, therefore a United Kingdom patent will only give rights in the UK to stop others from manufacturing or importing the patented products into the United Kingdom.
