the dead – though she has transformed into Ligeia. The story may be the narrator's opium-induced hallucination and there is debate whether the story was a satire. After the story's first publication in *The American Museum*, it was heavily revised and reprinted throughout Poe's life.

Poe's preference for not naming his narrators is potent once again in "The Tell-Tale Heart", a story that is trying so hard to appear sane, but fails miserably in the end. With minute preparations, perfect calculations, and even more precise execution of the conceived gruesome act, the narrator successfully

Backed by the numerous movie and theatrical adaptations, the story is considered one of Poe's most popular and critically acclaimed.
