In a bunker deep below Berlin's Old Reich Chancellery, Adolf Hitler and his new bride, Eva Braun, took their own lives just after 3:00 p.m. on April 30, 1945—Hitler by gunshot to the temple, Braun by

ingesting cyanide. But the F ü h r e r ' s suicide did not instantly end either Nazism or the Second World War in Europe.
